WHAT'S NEWS

KCA Board has approved beginning a financial savings plan with a goal of replacing the roof on the main dining hall. Metal roofing will replace the shingles, which are deteriorating rapidly. This will be a 2 year plan, taking 5% of normal offerings to set aside for this Building Fund. A goal of around \$8000 will be needed for this upgrade.

KID'S DEVOTION

2 Timothy 1:7 For God gave us a spirit NOT of fear but of power and love and self-control.

7 months have passed since you were introduced to KCA '19's theme: Fear: It Is a Liar. We often forget God's promises when we are really busy at school or having fun hanging out with our friends. God's promise to give us a spirit of power, love, and self-control is as true now as when you were at camp. It doesn't fade away, but we must be looking for it.

Power comes through having a daily routine when we not only talk to God, but we slow down to listen to His voice speaking to us through His Word.
