This option was deemed unfeasible at the June meeting, thus canceling the KCA "weeks" of camp in 2020.

## KID'S DEVOTION

#### **Repeat Daily**

"If it were that important, I would have remembered it" is a big fat lie we tell ourselves. Our abundant use of sticky notes, electronic organizers and calendars on the refrigerator attest to the fact that we function best with constant reminders. When God first gave instructions to the Israelites, he knew his people would need daily reminders.
